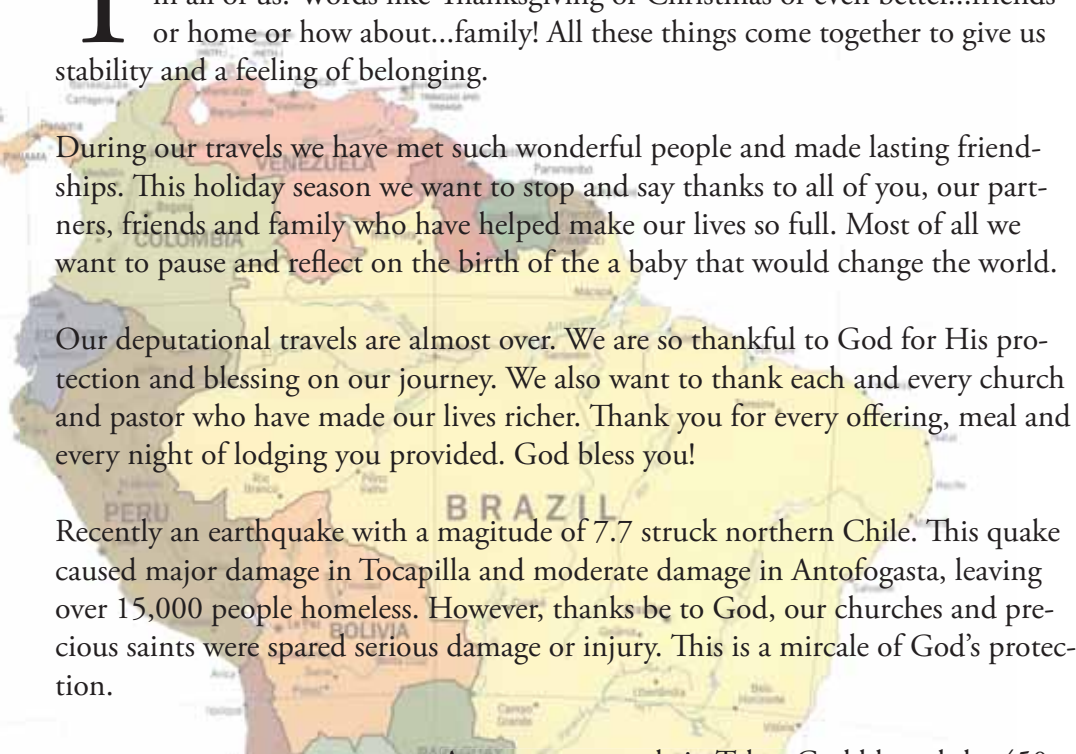
At a recent crusade in Talca, God blessed the 450 people that attended by filling 26 souls with the Holy Ghost and 9 were baptized. God is good!
